

Official Rules

Starting on April 7, 2017, Dana-Farber Cancer Institute and the Jimmy Fund (“DFCI”) will invite eligible participants via email, the Extra Mile Brunch event, Facebook (<http://www.facebook.com/JimmyFundWalk> and <http://www.facebook.com/TheJimmyFund>), Twitter (<http://www.twitter.com/TheJimmyFund>), and the Boston Marathon® Jimmy Fund Walk (the “Event”) website (<http://www.jimmyfundwalk.org>), to become a Pacesetter by raising funds in support of the Event, as described below. The first one hundred (100) participants who: (i) register for the Event and (ii) whose Event fundraising total equals or exceeds one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) on or before June 23, 2017 at 05:00pm EST (together, the “Pacesetters”) will receive the prize described below.

The winners will be determined at DFCI: 10 Brookline Place West, 6th Floor, Brookline, Massachusetts, on an ongoing basis until the earlier of (i) June 23, 2017 at 05:00pm EST, or (ii) the date on which one hundred (100) participants become Pacesetters. The Senior Vice President for Development, or her/his designee, shall be responsible for determining the names of the potential winners.

The potential winners will be notified by phone, mail and/or email. If a potential winner cannot be reached within twenty-four (24) hours from the first notification attempt, or if a participant is found to be ineligible, or if the notification is returned or undeliverable, or if a participant declines “winner” status, that participant will forfeit all rights as the winner, and an alternate winner will be selected. In the event the alternate winner declines the prize, the prize may be designated for another DFCI fundraising event at DFCI’s sole discretion. The prize will be shipped via a traceable method of delivery.

In order to be eligible to participate in the Event as a Pacesetter, a participant must, as of the date of entry, be a legal resident of one of the fifty (50) United States or the District of Columbia. Participants must be registered for the Event to be a Pacesetter. All personal fundraising, including matching funds from any employer or business, must be collected and submitted to DFCI in order to be included in a participant’s Event fundraising total.

The first one hundred (100) participants to become Pacesetters will receive two (2) tickets to the Boston Red Sox vs. Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim game at Fenway Park in Boston, Massachusetts on June 25, 2017 at 1:35pm EST, with seats located in the right field grandstand. This prize has a combined fair market value of sixty-five dollars (\$65) each.

All entries must be complete to be eligible. Deadline to enter is June 23, 2017 5:00pm EST.

Prizes are non-transferrable, non-refundable, non-negotiable, not redeemable for cash or for re-sale, and no substitution will be allowed. Prizes will not be replaced if lost or stolen. Other restrictions may apply. Should the prize become unavailable to DFCI for any reason, DFCI reserves the right to substitute an item of equal or lesser value. Winners may be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility, a receipt, a Certificate of Intent, and/or a waiver form provided by DFCI, prior to receipt of the prize.

The identities of the winners may be obtained by contacting the Boston Marathon® Jimmy Fund Walk staff at JimmyFundWalk@dfci.harvard.edu on or after June 24, 2017 at 5:00pm EST.

Any valuation of the prize stated above is based on available information provided to DFCI, and the value of any prize awarded to a winner may be reported for tax purposes as required by law. Winners are solely responsible for reporting and paying any and all applicable taxes related to the prize and for paying any expenses associated with a prize which is not specifically provided for in these Official Rules. Winners may be required to provide DFCI with valid identification and a valid taxpayer identification number or social security number before the prize will be awarded. Any person winning over \$600 in prizes from DFCI may receive an IRS form 1099 shortly following the end of the calendar year and a copy of such form will be filed with the IRS. Any person winning \$5,000 or more in prizes from DFCI may be required to pay the applicable taxes to DFCI before any prize will be awarded, per IRS regulations.

By participating in the Event as a Pacesetter as described above, participants agree to abide by all terms of these Official Rules and all decisions of DFCI, made in its sole discretion, which decisions shall be final. DFCI will interpret

these Official Rules and will resolve any disputes, conflicting claims or ambiguities concerning the rules or the Event, and DFCI's decisions concerning such disputes shall be final.

All participants, their heirs, executors and administrators, waive, release and forever discharge DFCI, all sponsoring entities, their respective trustees, directors, officers, employees, and agents, from all claims of liability, damages and rights of action of whatever nature or description, in equity or at law, present and future, that may arise out of or relate to participation in the Event as a Pacesetter, including the use of any prize.

DFCI is not responsible for lost or stolen prizes, incorrect or inaccurate transcription of entry information, for any human error, technical malfunctions, lost/delayed data transmission, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries, for line failures or other failures of any telephone network, server, providers, computer equipment, software or any combination thereof, for inability to access any web site or online service or any other error or malfunction, or for late, lost, illegible, misdirected or incomplete entries which may limit a participant's ability to participate in the drawing. DFCI is not responsible for technical, hardware or software failures of any kind, lost or unavailable network connections or failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed transmissions.

The contest and Event are governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. By participating in the Event as a Pacesetter, each participant consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts located in Suffolk County, Massachusetts, for resolution of all disputes.
